

# Indicator: Connectivity of Local Protected Lands

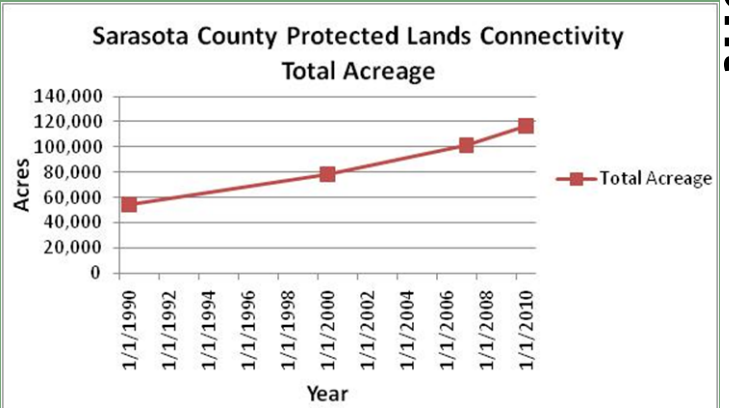
**Description:** Total acreage of protected lands — preserved and conserved land areas larger than 50 acres.

**Sources:** 1. Sarasota County Resource Management Office—Provided GIS Maps & Data Tables

**Caveats:** Protected Lands include public and private natural and environmentally sensitive areas that are designated for conservation or preservation uses. Connected lands enable wildlife (and sometime humans) to move easily from one protected area to the next. Areas exhibit "connectivity" if they are less than 110 feet apart or connected by a wildlife accessible underpass. "Sites" are those geographic areas with 50 or more contiguous acres.
