

# Indicator: Public Transportation

**Description:** Percentage of workers age 16 years and older who typically take public transportation to work (excluding a taxicab).

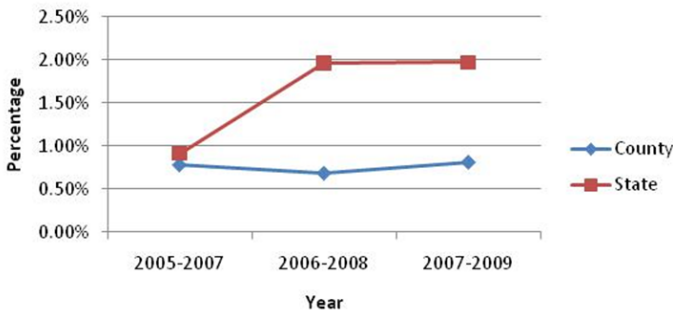

The percentage is calculated using the total number of workers age 16 years and older riding public transportation (excluding taxicabs) divided by the total number of workers ages 16 years and older. 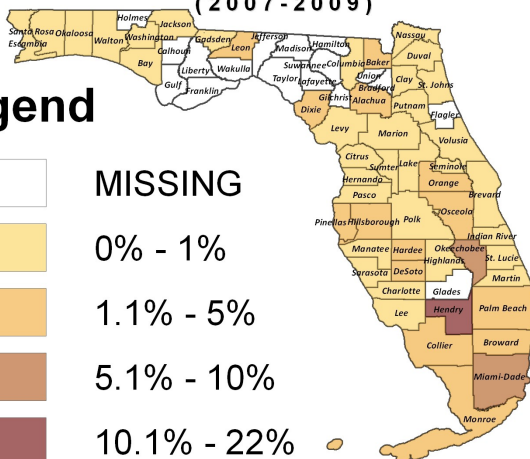
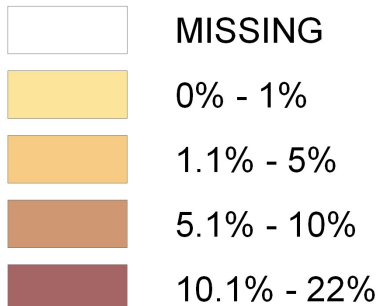
Percentage of Workers Who Use Public Transportation

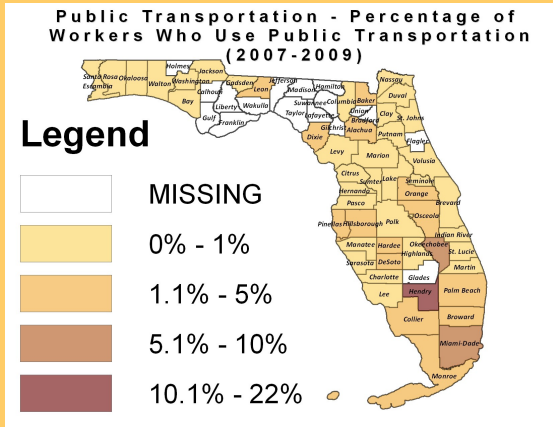
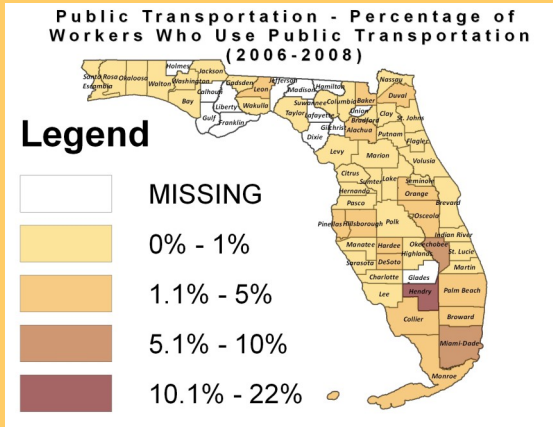
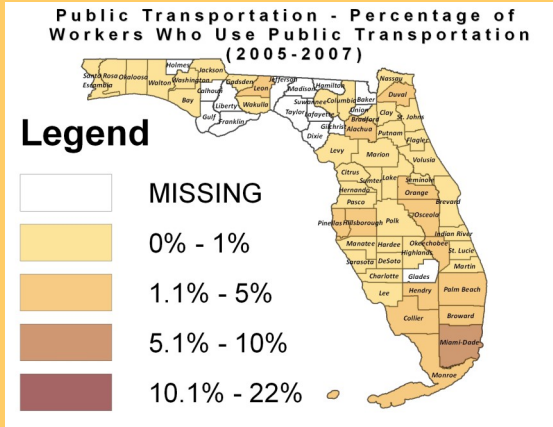
