

Indicator: Residential Permits

Description: Number of residential permits issued per 100,000 people.

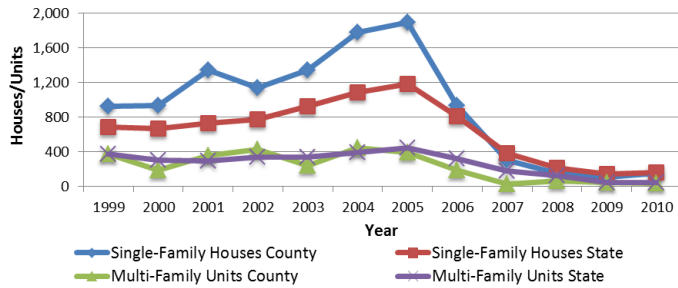

Caveats: A building permit is required to build a new single-family house or multifamily building. Permits are presented per 100,000 people to reflect changes in permits and not just changes in the size of the population. Multifamily buildings are built to house more than one family, such as apartment buildings. “Multifamily” reflects the number of units permitted, not the number of buildings. The 2001 increase in single-family permits reflects a change in the way permits were counted. Maps are presented using the reported number of housing unit permits divided by the total population.

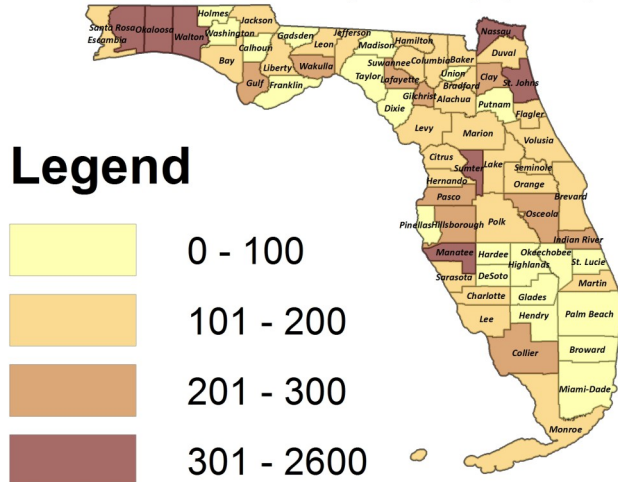

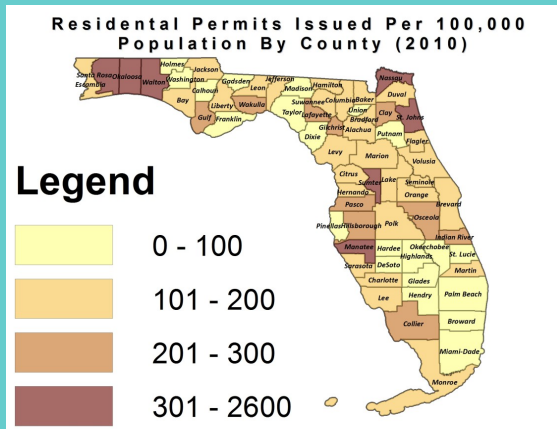
