

# Indicator: Traffic Crash Fatalities

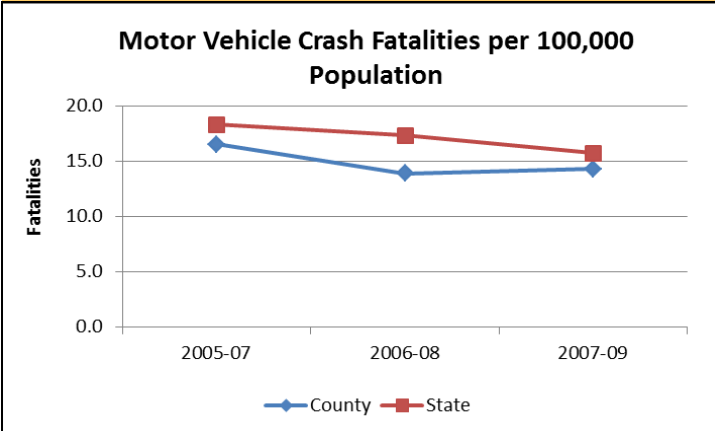
**Description:** Number of traffic crash fatalities per 100,000 people.

**Sources:** Florida Department of Health, Bureau of Vital Statistics

**Caveats:** Traffic crash fatalities are presented per 100,000 people to reflect changes in fatalities and not just changes in the size of the population. Data is presented as an age-adjusted 3-year rolling average—the average number of fatalities over rolling 3-year periods. It is calculated using the Year 2000 standard population proportion.

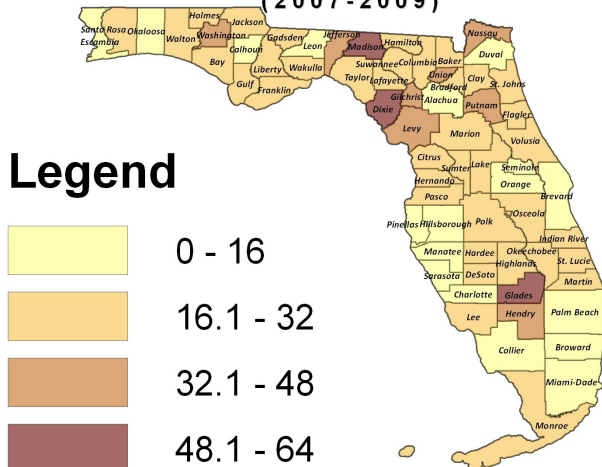
